Gwendolyn Gloria (Geisness) Isham, age 90, passed away peacefully at the Park Manor Nursing home in Park Falls Wisconsin on April 05, 2020. She was born in Baldwin, Wisconsin on July 30, 1929 the first of 7 children born to the late Helen and Alvin Geisness. In 1934 the family moved to a farm near Lugerville, Wisconsin where they raised their family.
