Cecelia Catherine Fenzl, 72, of Park Falls, peacefully passed away at home Saturday, July 22,

2017. She was born in Tomah, Wisconsin on February 14, 1945 to Charles and Cecelia (Ramer)

Kerska. Cecelia was the youngest of five children and spent her childhood on her family's dairy farm in rural Monroe County. She was a member of Tomah High School graduating class of 1963. She followed her sister's footsteps and attended St Joseph School of Nursing in Marshfield where she graduated in 1966. Nearly 50 years ago to the date, on July 29, 1967, she married James Fenzl at St Mary Catholic Church in Tomah. Together, they resided and raised a family in Park Falls. Cecelia started work as a Registered Nurse at then Park Falls Memorial Hospital in 1967, retiring in 2011 after 44 years of service from the current Flambeau Hospital. Ceily, as she was known to most coworkers, worked both as a floor RN as well as an obstetrical nurse assisting with many deliveries throughout her career. She was a founding member of the Flambeau Hospital "Sunshine" Club and Old Timer's Club. In her leisure time, Cecelia enjoyed knitting, crocheting, cross-stitching, embroidering, quilting, reading novels and biographies, flower gardening, as well as having good conversation over coffee with neighbors, friends and family. 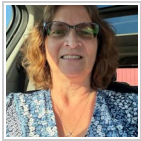
