Christopher James Ferkovich

age 60, of Park Falls passed peacefully at Marshfield Medical Center in Park Falls, surrounded by family on Sunday, December 29, 2024. He began school in LaCrosse and -after moving with his family- graduated from Park Falls High School. Chris went on to obtain his certificate of sales from NTC in Wausau. He returned to Park Falls and worked for several local companies including IAP, Marquip, and Steuber Beverage, before finding his real joy as the “Juke Box Hero,” DJ-ing events and parties for many years before retiring. He joined his family as a member of the First Congregational United Church of Christ. Chris made friends everywhere he went, and built lifelong relationships easily. He generously shared all of those as an active member of the community, bringing the Christmas Magic to local events as Santa Claus, fundraising, and volunteering with the Jaycees. He was a devoted Packer and Brewer fan who could always be counted on to share the game schedule and be sporting team colors. 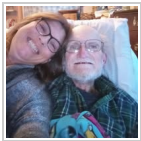

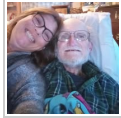
