Birch Street Funeral Service is assisting the Family.

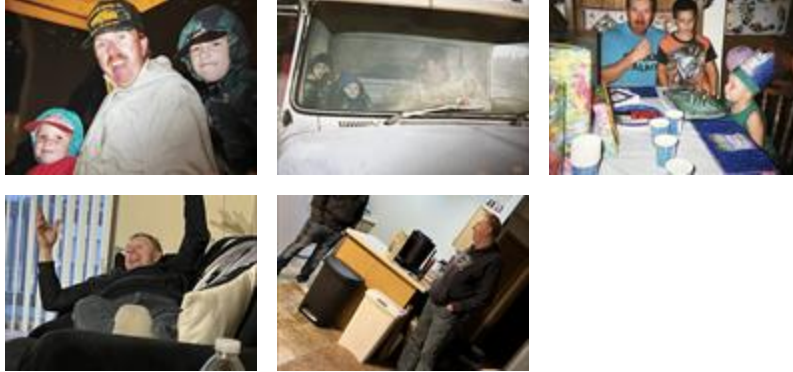

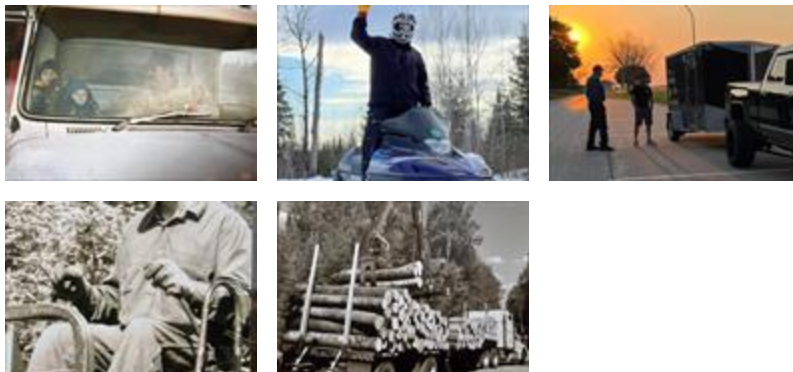
