### David John Mathe

age 75, of Glidden, formerly of Oshkosh, died on Monday October 4, 2021 at his home. He was born on July 9, 1946 in Oshkosh, the son of Norbert and Delores (Kloiber) Mathe. After his schooling he entered the United States Navy, serving his country during the Vietnam War from 1964-1968. David worked for A.P.
