Dean Wayland Edwardson, 76, passed away unexpectedly at his winter home in Granite Shoals, Texas on March 15, 2016. He was the son of Elmer and Lenore (Vogel) Edwardson, born on June 19, 1939 in Edgerton, Wisconsin. Dean graduated from Milton Union High school in 1957 and then proudly served in the U.S. Army from 1962 to 1964.
