Frances "Fran" Lucille (Haun) Neuberger passed away peacefully at Park Manor in Park Falls on November 22, 2019. She was 91.

Fran was born September 29, 1928. She was one of five children born to George and Anna (Kronberger) Haun, and her early life and schooling were in Butternut. She met her husband Edward "Ed" George Neuberger at a dance, and they were married on June 26, 1946. She and Ed homesteaded a dairy farm north of Butternut. They had the last of their six children in 1967. Fran began working as a health and special education aide at the Glidden School that same year and enjoyed her work there for over 30 years. She moved from her farm to Flambeau Heights in Park Falls in 2007 and leaves behind many friends that were made during her time there. She loved reading, a good Western movie, and spending time with her family.
