He was the youngest of four sons born to Margaret (Wells) and John Draxler. Frank was raised at Crowley Dam, where his dad was the operator for Flambeau Paper Company. He graduated from Lincoln High School in 1949. While employed at Universal in Park Falls, he met Rosy Schmidt, who would become the love of his life. They were married on October 17, 1953 at St. Anthony's Catholic Church, and their eight children were all baptized there. While raising their family, they made time for numerous recreational activities. Frank enjoyed snowmobiling on area trails, poker parties with friends, and cribbage with anyone who didn't mind getting skunked. He spent many hours deer hunting and telling stories about deer hunting adventures. Frank has been an owner of the Green Bay Packers since 1997. On football Sundays his kids remember him taking a transistor radio to work on second shift at the Flambeau Paper Mill so he could listen to the end of the game. Annual Woodcutting Weekends were typically held in October. His children, grandchildren, and eventually great-grandchildren would come to cut, split, and pile wood for use in the winter. Frank and Rosy were lifelong members of St. Anthony's Catholic Church and their children all attended Catholic school in Park Falls. Frank was also a member of the Knights of Columbus. During his life journey, Frank mourned the loss of his

daughter Joanie, his son John, and in 2004, the loss of Rosy, his wife of fifty years. In spite of these losses, he continued to put his complete trust in the Lord. His devotion to Our Lady prompted him to pray daily rosaries for those he loved.
