Age 91, of Park Falls, was peacefully called to be with the Lord at his home on Saturday February 2, 2019, with the love of his life by his side, his children, and his faithful companion “Tilly”. He was born on March 13, 1927 in the Town of Lake, the son of Joseph and Anna (Pichler) Wagner. Frank was raised in Butternut, growing up on the family farm in the town of Chippewa. Frank was a fixture in the Park Falls community throughout his life. He served as president of the St. Anthony’s School Board, was a member of the Knights of Columbus, a City of Park Falls Councilman, a member of the Park Falls American Legion and VFW Posts with his mural proudly depicted on the wall of the American Legion Hall. All who met him will remember his kind presence and smile, especially with his dedication to Valley Laundry where he enjoyed interacting with locals and tourists from around the area.

Frank served in the United States Army during the Korean War and married his love Betty Fleming after his return on November 29, 1952. They shared 66 years together. Frank loved his family deeply and our extended Weiberg family. In 2013 he participated in the Never Forgotten Honor Flight to Washington DC.

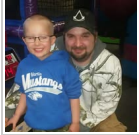

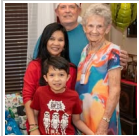
