age 75, of Park Falls, died on Wednesday February 26, 2025, at his home. He was born on September 26, 1949, in Park Falls, the son of Rudolph and Margaret (Koller) Hoefflerle. He attended the Park Falls High School and was known for his work ethic, working two to three jobs at a time. During his Senior year of high school, he worked at Vincent & Vincent Ford and as a night manager at St. Croix. For many years he worked at St. Croix and Holiday Gas Station at the same time. In 1974 he was transferred to Shopper Manufacturing in Edina, MN, while the family resided in Brooklyn Park, MN. In 1978 the family returned to Park Falls. At That time, he worked for St. Croix doing remodeling, was a caretaker for Gordon Schluter at Thunderhead Resort, and began working in the woods. For 36 years Fred worked as a logger. Gordon referred to Fred as his right-hand man. On March 9, 1968, he was united in marriage to Patricia "Patty" Moe. Fred enjoyed spending time in the outdoors, taking long walks in the woods, watching the History Channel, Ancient Aliens, and scientific shows. He also enjoyed playing Uno with family. He was teased because he could memorize the other player's hand and knew their next move.

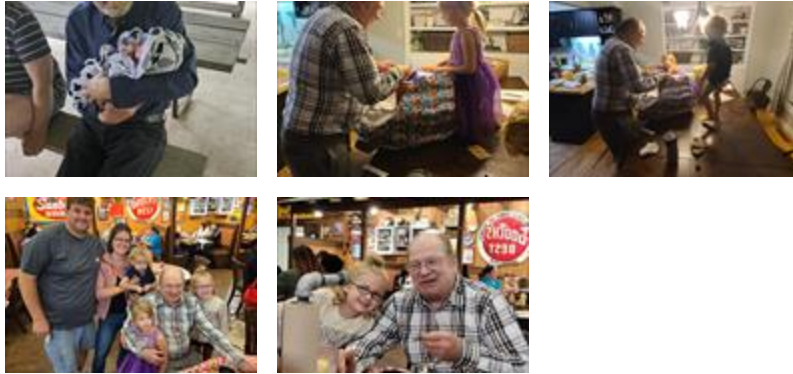
