On Sunday December 18th, 2022, Jeffrey John Roth, beloved father, brother, and grandfather passed away peacefully surrounded by his family. Jeff was born September 25th, 1953, in Chicago, Illinois, to John and Elizabeth Roth. Jeff graduated from Maine South High School in Park Ridge Illinois in 1971. He pursued his passion for the outdoors and fishing by attending the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point. Jeff graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Fisheries Biology and Management and worked as a fisheries biologist for the Wisconsin DNR for 34 years. Jeff started as a limited term employee in Park Falls and worked his way up to managing all the water bodies for Iron and Ashland counties, he retired from this position in 2010. During this time Jeff also started his own private fisheries consultation firm, AquaTech, which he continued up until his passing.

Jeff was an avid Houndsman, dog trainer, and musher. He started hunting in college and his passion for the sport only grew throughout the years. Jeff was an all-around outdoorsman he enjoyed many pursuits including, trapping, fishing and camping. Jeff enjoyed bear hunting the most and he passed this love onto his sons, but he also made an effort to introduce others to hunting. He was a great advocate for the sport and took out many Learn to Hunt participants and mentored many others over the years.

In his retirement Jeff enjoyed spending time with his family, his best friend Roger, fishing in the pond, and bird hunting with Champ.

Jeff was the proud father of and is survived by three sons; Adam of

Menomonie, Ryan (Alaina), and Marc (Jenelle) of Park Falls and grandfather to his pride and joy Ruthann. Jeff is also survived by his sister Lyn Hanke (Rich) of Manitowoc, niece Jena Denk and nephew Eric Hanke, and best friend Roger Jasinski of Park Falls, as well many other family and friends. 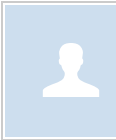
