John Henry "Booper" Jehn

age 89, of Park Falls, died on Sunday January 26, 2015 at Park Manor Nursing Home in Park Falls. He was born on November 20, 1925 in Prentice, the son of William E. and Frances (Heiderer) Jehn. After graduating from Butternut High School, John served in the United States Navy on the USS ROI during WWII. He then attended St. Norbert College. John began his banking career at Northern State Bank in Ashland, WI. He worked for Thorp Finance for 27 years and then for First National Bank for another 27 years. On October 17, 1959, he married Marlys "Bonnie" Michalski in Park Falls. They enjoyed 55 years of marriage. Booper loved and served his community. He was a member of St. Anthony of Padua Church where he served as a communion minister, greeter, and hospital minister. He was the Village President of Butternut and served on the Park Falls School Board and Price County Board of Supervisors.
