Lillian worked as a legal secretary for DeBardleben in Phillips and was active throughout her life in many organizations. 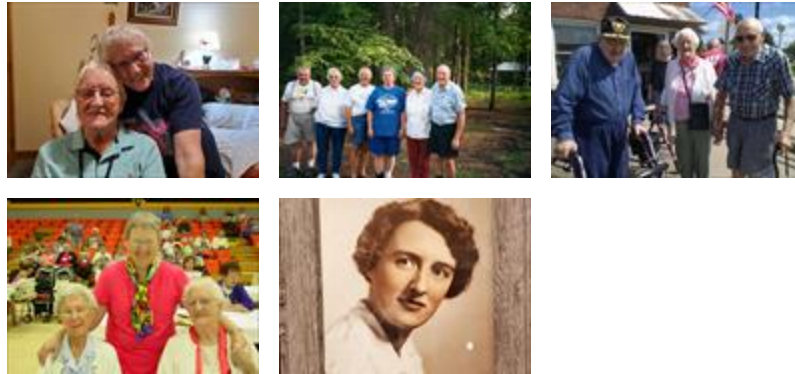
