Born to George and Beatrice (Senkbeil) Kelnhofer on March 8, 1938, Linda was raised in Park Falls and graduated from Lincoln High School. On April 27, 1957, she married Lawrence Lee Lobermeier.

Until her youngest child was in school, Linda was an active stay-at-home mother. At various times in her life, she worked as a photography assistant, a rod winder for St. Croix, a clerk at Jeske Drug, a wreath maker, and an election worker. She was active in Christian Women and gave to the church by serving on the funeral luncheon committee and cleaning the church.

Whether it was gliding to a waltz or free-styling to something contemporary, Linda loved to dance. She enjoyed movie nights, birthday lunches, and playing cards with “the girls,” and her independent spirit led her to travel with family and friends. Athletic and competitive, she played softball until age 50 and pitched horseshoes until age 70. She used her creativity to decorate her home with items found at auctions and in nature. She enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren and attending their functions. Family will miss Linda’s laugh but will keep alive stories of her dressing as a Christmas Elf and of her “big kill” during hunting season. Her open door policy during the holidays

meant the house was filled with family and friends.

Linda is survived by her children, Barbara Lobermeier of Madison, Tom (Cindy) Lobermeier of Park Falls, Cathie (Bill) Abel of Park Falls, and Dan (Anna) Lobermeier of Neenah; grandchildren, Amanda (Toby) Heyn, Andrew (Megan) Heeter, Dana and David Lobermeier, Michelle and Miranda Lobermeier; great-grandchildren, Maxwell Heyn and Zoey Heeter; brother Robert (Myrlene) Kelnhofer of Hideaway, TX; other relatives and friends.
