Lorraine attended Wilson State Grade school in Kaiser and Lincoln High School in Park Falls. She went to Chicago, IL in 1942 where she worked at many different jobs including the Veterans Administration in Hines, IL and Victor Gasket Company.

She married Kasper J. Daubner on June 30, 1950. They had three children together, Janet, William, and Wayne. She also had three step-children, Len (Shirley), Arlyss (James), and Patricia (Tom). They were married forty-seven and a half years when Kasper passed away on January 20, 1998.

The family returned to Park Falls in 1969. In 1974 Lorraine went to work at Park Manor working in many capacities. She continued her education at NCTI in Wausau and correspondence courses with University of Wisconsin. In 1981 she obtained her Nursing Home Administrators license. She worked as Administrator at Mellen Manor for ten years after which she returned to Park Manor and retired from there in 1998.

Lorraine is a past member of the Park Falls Hospital Auxiliary, Grey Ladies, Board of Aging, Wisconsin Association of Nursing Homes and AHCA. She loved playing bridge, traveling and being a homemaker. She and Bill spent their winters in Fort Myers where they had a home and summers in Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

She married William Dresden of Eau Claire on June 2, 2001. There were three step-children, Mary (Dave) Badger, Catherine (Bill) McCann, and Patricia Prock (deceased).

She is survived by her husband William of sixteen years, her children, Janet (John) Garrett of Jacksboro, Tennessee, William (Linda) of Park Falls, and Wayne (Barbara) of Stoughton.
