Lucille Marjorie (Wallace) Heinlein, age 85, of Glidden, peacefully departed her earthly residence for her eternal home in heaven to be with her Redeemer on July 25, 2016 at Park Manor surrounded by her loving husband and children.

Lucille was born on May 11, 1931 in Golden, Colorado, to Guy and Verna (Fraser) Wallace. On February 6, 1948 she married Melvin Junior Heinlein, in Lakewood, Colorado.

The couple worked at Kincaid Pharmacy in Lakewood, CO and became partners in the business. Every summer they would take their children on a road trip to Glidden, the hometown of Melvin, to visit the Heinlein side of the family.

After moving to Glidden in 1970, Lucille worked at Druschke's Drug Store and then in the Glidden School kitchen, eventually becoming a Title 1 Aide. She also taught Sunday School, Confirmation Class, Vacation Bible School and was a member of the Mission Circle at Trinity Lutheran Church, Glidden where she regularly worshiped and attended Bible Study. In retirement she enjoyed a number of years working for with the Senior Community Service Employment Program U.S. Forest Service U.S.D.A. maintaining campgrounds and signage.

She enjoyed shopping, traveling, cheering for the Green Bay Packers, sewing and making crafts. She loved spending time with her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, friends and relatives.

Lucille is survived by her husband Melvin of Glidden, three children: Sheryl (Bill) Launer of O'Fallon, MO, Dale (Dianne) Heinlein of Park Falls, WI, Mark (Connie) Heinlein of Negaunee, MI, Eight grandchildren, Ten great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

Lucille was preceded in death by her parents, her siblings: Warren, Orville, Arnold Wallace, and Louise (Wallace) White and son, Thomas Heinlein.
