Melvin was born on December 28, 1927 in Peeksville. He served in the United States Army Air Forces at the conclusion of WWII typing discharge orders for military personnel returning from deployment. On February 6, 1948 he married Lucille Wallace in Lakewood, CO.

After typing his own discharge papers from military service, he worked at Kincaid Pharmacy in Lakewood, CO, eventually becoming a partner in the business. He sold his share of the business to his partner in 1970 and moved to Glidden to be close to his family. He worked as a logger. He enjoyed family, friends, and serving his Savior actively in church. In retirement he worked a number of years with the Senior community Service Employment Program U.S. Forest Service U.S.D.A. maintaining campgrounds and signage.

Melvin was a loving, extremely patient and honest, and enjoyed staying busy. He served as an elder, custodian, and in many other capacities at Trinity Lutheran Church in Glidden. He enjoyed shopping, traveling, cheering for the Green Bay Packers, being with loved ones, and playing cards.
