age 79, of Park Falls, died on Wednesday September 14, 2016 at Flambeau Hospital in Park Falls. He was born on August 26, 1937 in Chicago, the son of Frank Peter and Violet Ruby (Hesse) Wojcieszak. His early life and schooling were in Chicago ,where he graduated from high school. Richard earned a bachelors degree in Bacteriology and worked for the City of Chicago Department of Water as a bacteriologist and the OSHA Safety Director for 37 years until his retirement. On May 22, 1966 he married the love of his life, Ann Bengtson in Chicago. In 1971the couple purchased Wojcieszak's Flambeau Resort. They continued to own and operate the resort and the Sportsmans Lounge. Owning this resort was Richard's lifelong dream. Richard was a member of the Masonic Lodge 32nd Degree, the Shriners, & the Flambeau Clowns for many years. He was the first president of the Price County ATV association, a member of the Fifield Dirt Devils ATV club, the Fifield Sno Drovers and Eisenstein Bushwackers snowmobile clubs and a lifetime member of the NRA.
