Wayne Marose of “Marosestead”, Wisconsin, age 67 passed away unexpectedly in his sleep on August 23, 2023. Wayne was born in Fond du Lac on September 11, 1955, to Carl and Jean (Thill) Marose. He spent his first seven years of life in Mayville and the family then moved to Fond du Lac. At age 10, the Maroses moved to Stockbridge where his parents owned and operated Carl and Jean’s bar. Wayne, Janice and their son Michael called Chilton their home for 30 years residing on the Manitowoc River.

After graduating from Stockbridge High School in 1974, Wayne was employed at Keller Structures in Kaukauna. This is where he utilized and honed his God-given carpentry skills. He then moved on to Tecumseh Products in New Holstein as a machinist. Due to an unstable economy, he went onto Horst Distributing in Chilton for a more steady, guaranteed employment to provide for his family.
